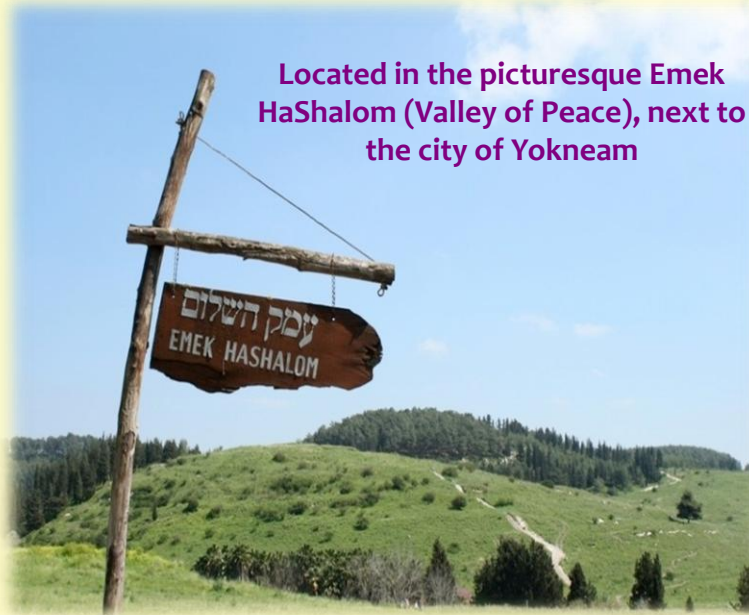


Experience Nature in a Unique Way with LOTEm- Making Nature Accessible
